

Welcome to Hope Sabbath School—an in-depth interactive study of the Word of God. We are continuing our series on Prophets of God. Today's topic: PROPHEPIC MANIFESTATION IN CRUCIAL MOMENTS.

1) The prophet Noah at a time of impending judgment

- a. What was the situation on earth when Noah was called to be a prophet of God? Genesis 6:1-5,12-13
- b. Where do you see mercy mixed with judgment in the response of the LORD to the wickedness that was rampant on the earth? Genesis 6:6-8,14
- c. The Apostle Peter called Noah “a preacher of righteousness” (2 Peter 2:5). What was the greatest sermon Noah preached as a prophet of God? Genesis 6:22, Hebrews 11:7
- d. Noah was 600 years old when the flood came upon the earth. He had been preaching and building for 120 years. How had his family expanded during that time? Genesis 5:32
- e. How did the prophetic ministry of Noah, preaching and building, impact his three sons? Genesis 7:7
- f. How many people accepted the call to repentance during the prophetic ministry of Noah?

2) Prophets of God down through the ages

- a. What other prophets of God were sent at crucial moments down through the ages? Moses, Daniel, John the Baptist, etc.
- b. What can we learn from these prophetic messages about the character of God? Amos 3:7, John 3:16, 2 Peter 3:9, etc.

3) The prophet/apostle John with an end-time message

- a. The apostle John is perhaps best known for his inspired writing of the fourth Gospel. What verses in John's Gospel have been a blessing to your life?
- b. What additional prophetic work was given to the Apostle John? Revelation 1:1-6, 22:8-10
- c. What important prophetic messages have you discovered in the Book of Revelation? Revelation 1:7, 14:6-7, 21:1-5, 22:1-5, etc.
- d. Why are the prophetic messages contained in the Book of Revelation so relevant for our lives today?
- e. What solemn warning was given at the conclusion of the Revelation of Jesus Christ? Revelation 22:18-19 (see also Revelation 20:15, 17:8)
- f. How can our names remain in the Book of Life? Revelation 3:5 (see also Revelation 12:10-11)
- g. What does it mean to overcome by the blood of the Lamb?
- h. Reflect on the story of Stephen the deacon who overcame by the blood of the Lamb and the word of his testimony. Acts 6:8-10,15, 7:54-60
- i. How can we be free from fear as we prepare for the fulfillment of end-time prophecies? 1 John 4:17-18, Luke 12:22-32, etc.
