

Part #13 BLESSINGS FROM THE
PROPHETIC WORD

Scripture Song: Listen to counsel – Proverbs 19:20

Welcome to Hope Sabbath School—an in-depth interactive study of the Word of God. We are concluding our series on Prophets of God. Today's topic: BLESSINGS FROM THE PROPHETIC WORD.

1) Prophets of God point us to Jesus

- a. John 5:39 What testimony did Jesus give about the inspired writings of the prophets of God?
- b. What revelation was given to two disciples on the day of Christ's resurrection? Luke 24:27
- c. Under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit as a prophet of God, what revelation did the Apostle John give about Jesus? John 1:1-4,14
- d. Where do you see Jesus most clearly revealed in the testimony of the prophets of God?

2) Prophets of God affirm the reliability of the Scriptures

- a. 2 Peter 1:19-21 What inspired testimony did the Apostle Peter give about the prophets of God?
- b. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 What was the testimony of the Apostle Paul about the prophets of God?
- c. What other testimonies affirm the reliability of the Scriptures?

3) Prophets of God share light and truth

- a. Psalm 119 is an inspired testimony about the excellence of the Scriptures. Consider the following verses: Psalm 119:105,130,160, etc.
- b. John 17:17 What testimony did Jesus give about the Word of God?
- c. What light and truth did Jesus find in the inspired testimony of the prophet Moses when responding to the temptations of Satan? Matthew 4:4,7,10

- d. What appeal did the Apostle Paul make to the young preacher Timothy? 2 Timothy 4:1-5
- e. Why is the light and truth of the Scriptures so important for our lives today?
- f. Share a time when your study of the prophets of God brought light and truth to your life.

4) Prophets of God bring comfort and hope

- a. What important reminder did the Apostle Paul give to Christians in Rome? Romans 15:4-6
- b. Share a time in your life when you needed comfort and hope. What testimonies of the prophets of God were especially meaningful to you?

5) Prophets of God call us to unity in Christ

- a. What was the prayer of Jesus for all who would believe in Him through the testimony of the prophets and apostles? John 17:20-26
- b. Read the appeal of the Apostle Paul in Philippians 2:1-4. Is the call to unity in Christ an appeal or a promise?

6) A blessing promised

- a. Why is the appeal of King Jehoshaphat so relevant for our lives today? 2 Chronicles 20:20
